- It was reported the total number of responses from the Village was 14. Whilst very low this could be construed as positive.
- There were a few points worthy of consideration for alteration to the plan. These mainly related to Policy HAR1 and concerned clarification on small development outside of the settlement boundary: in particular to points in subsections c.d.e. in the HAR1 policy statement.
- Also suggestions were raised on the need to include within Community Action for a replacement village hall of the need to include improved energy efficiency within the project brief. As well as the need for the Design codes for new builds or extensions to cover energy efficiency.
- It was reported that West Suffolk Council and Suffolk County Council responses did not raise any issues of concern or requiring change.
- Ian Poole indicated he would be in a position to produce a response document by the end of November on matters raised.
- It was agreed we should thank the Village for their consideration and responses. Colin agreed to place an entry in the December Village Newsletter.
- Ian indicated a formal response document would be produced and any changes noted. The
  document would be placed on the Village website.
- In terms of the next steps for the Parish Council there would be a need at the next meeting (January), to note any changes to the plan as a result of consultation, agree to the changes and formally agree for the revised plan to be submitted to WSC for their formal consultation process.
